Hard to believe it's almost time to file your tax return again! Please use this handy checklist to help assemble your 2019 income tax information.

As always, once you have all your tax slips together, you can drop them off at my house or mail them directly to me. I will review everything with you and get the T183 signed before your return is filed.

Please watch out for email scams - the Canada Revenue Agency NEVER communicates to individuals via email. No matter how authentic the email may seem, do not open anything that looks like it comes from the CRA.

Every year I attend several tax and related conferences as part of my ongoing professional development requirements. This year one specific session really stood out - it was put on by the Canadian Institute of Certifed Executor Advisors (CICEA). Here are some interesting statistics:

- $\rightarrow$  70% of Canadians do not have a current or valid Will
- $\rightarrow$  85% of Canadians either haven't thought about their Estate or expect to leave < \$100,000
- $\rightarrow$  98% of Canadians intend to name a family member as their Executor
- $\rightarrow$  1,019 Canadians turn 65 every day

With this in mind, I've got some exciting news to share with you. I've started a new business called **JOA Executor Solutions**, which was created to help Executors and their families deal with the many issues surrounding a family member's Estate.
